

Public Hearing of the Town of Poland Board October 8, 2019

Town Supervisor Snow called the Public Hearing to order at 6:58 p.m. In attendance were Town Council members Corey Swanson, Stevan Hatfield, Norm Gustafson and Terry Walker. Also present were Director of Housing Rehab Services Eileen Powers, town residents Cindy Parsons, and Post-Journal stringer Rose Mary Carver.

Supervisor Snow opened the floor to the Director of Housing Rehab Services Eileen Powers.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear public comments on the Town of Poland's Current Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Director Powers gave a brief explanation of the grant. This is the town's fourth Block Grant program. A proposal was written to assist 8 low income homeowners in the Town of Poland and the total award was \$385,000.00. At this time, 9 homes have been contracted which exceeded our goal by one. The project status is as follows: 4 projects have been completed, 2 are under construction and 3 are to contract.

After explaining the project further, Director Powers opened the floor for questions.

Supervisor Snow thanked Director Powers and the rehab staff for all the hard work they do for the Town of Poland and the town definitely benefits from this program.

Supervisor Snow made a motion, seconded by Councilman Hatfield to close the Public Hearing at 7:05 p.m.
