

Public Hearing of the Town of Poland Board October 27, 2020

Town Supervisor Snow called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. with the pledge to the flag. In attendance were Town Council members Corey Swanson, Stevan Hatfield, Norman Gustafson and Terry Walker. Also present was Highway Superintendent Larry Mee and Post-Journal Stringer Rose Mary Carver.

CHANGES TO BUDGET SINCE LAST WORK SESSION:

- 1) The majority of the .1 (personnel) were given a 2% raise.
- 2) Contingency fund (A1990.4) changed from \$8,000 to \$10,000
- 3) The Highway asked for a 2.5% raise in pay but received a 2% raise
- 4) Employer FICA & Medicare (A9030.8) increased 2% with the .1 (personnel)

The Tax Cap report has been filed and excepted with the State.
The Town stayed under the tax cap by \$9,480.59.
