

Public Hearing of the Town of Poland on Local Law #1 for 2021 For Cannabis Dispensaries and on-site Consumption Sites

A public hearing was held on Tuesday, September 14th at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Hall at 3593 Church Street, Kennedy, New York.

Supervisor Snow opened the Public Hearing at 6:30 p.m. with the Pledge to the flag. In attendance were Supervisor Kelly Snow, Councilman Corey Swanson, Councilman Stevan Hatfield, Councilman Norman Gustafson and Councilman Terry Walker. Also present were Highway Superintendent, Attorney Joel Seachrist and Post-Journal stringer Rose Mary Carver.

Town Clerk Bonnita Wallace read aloud the Legal Notice:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Poland, New York on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall, Church Street, Kennedy, New York, regarding the adoption of Local Law No. 1 for the year 2021, by which the Town of Poland would opt out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption sites within the Town.
